

**Southern Division Outdoor Emergency Transportation  
Instructor Continuing Education  
April 30, 2025**

National Ski Patrol OET Instructors must complete required continuing education requirements within a three (3) year cycle. Courses or activities can be completed at any time during the cycle.

**Responsibilities**

You are responsible to track your continuing education activities and provide records of completion or attendance to the Region OET Administrator within the three-year recertification cycle. Your education records are available on the NSP.Org website under 'profile' page.

**Requirements**

Current NSP policy requires completion of two (2) types of courses,

- One "dryland" course consisting of Instructor Development review and/or administrative review
- One "on snow" event

More details of the combination of OET Instructor continuing education courses can be found in the current NSP Policies and Procedures (NSP P&P), Appendix E, Outdoor Emergency Transportation.

**DRYLAND**

- OET Instructor Continuing Education Clinic (OETICE) or
- NSP Instructor Skills Review for Continuing Education (REINS)

**ON SNOW**

- Snowsport Trainer Workshop (STW)
- Toboggan Trainer Workshop (TTW)
- Senior Alpine Trainer/Evaluator Clinic (STEN)
- AASI/PSIA update event

Other ski and toboggan and instructor related activities and certifications may be considered to satisfy continuing education requirements. Other events as approved by the division OET supervisor such as certifications and activities may include, but are not limited to

**Dryland:**

- Instructor Continuing Education from other programs, such as OEC, that include Instructor Development Review.
- Online instructor administrative modules

**On snow:**

- PSIA/AASI certification or continuing education events
